The following Instructions refer to the steps needed for proper contact insertion/extraction when using our ATV 38POS plugs and receptacles.



QXRT16	Extraction Tool for #16 Contact
ATV38-RT01-PIN	Extraction Tool for #16 Contact
ATV38-RT02-SOC	Extraction Tool for #16 Contact


### ATV 38POS Receptacle: Contact Insertion

Crimp pin contacts(SC000571X) to wire. See appropriate datasheets for application tool.



### Step 3

Push contact straight into connector until a positive stop is felt. A slight tug will confirm that it is properly locked in position.








Section View showing final position of contact for reference.


#### Step 5

Crimp pin contacts(SPXXM1X) to wire. See appropriate datasheets for application tool.




### Step 7

Push contact straight into connector until a positive stop is felt. A slight tug will confirm that it is properly locked in position.




### Step 9

Push the wedge vertically into receptacle after the wedge align to the Hole of the receptacle.





Use the small end of the AT Extraction Tool(ATRT-100) to pry open the 2 side clasps and remove the Location Block.





Use one end of the workpiece to extend the clamp of the pressure plate.  $\,$ 





The wedge out the connector.





Wrap the contact with the tool (ATV38-RT01-PIN) and push the cover out of the receptacle.





Use a removal tool(QXRT16) to press the SPXXM1X contacts  $\mbox{ spring and }\mbox{ remove it.}$ 





Use a removal tool(ATV38-RT02-SOC) to open the plastic buckle and remove the SC000571X contacts.






Section View showing final position of contact for reference.




Sectional view of tool and terminal matching for pick-up.
