RoHS Statement

The Directive 2011/65/EU (Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment) prohibits the use or distribution of the following materials with the provided percentages by weight in homogeneous materials: lead (0.1%), mercury (0.1%), cadmium (0.01%), hexavalent chromium (0.1%), polybrominated biphenyl (PBB) (0.1%) and diphenyl ether (PBDE) (0.1%). In doing so, Amphenol Tuchel Industrial makes frequent use of Exemption 6a + 6a-I (Lead as an alloying element in steel), of Exemption 6b + 6b-I + 6b-II (Lead as an alloying element in aluminum) and of Exemption 6c (Lead as an element in copper alloy).

Due to the Directive 2015/863/EU since 22 July 2019 the existing six banned substances were expanded to include the four flame retarders di-(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1%), butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1%), dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1%) and di-isobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1%).

All of our products – **with the exception of some customer-specific solutions** – are RoHS compliant, **including the above mentioned additional four substances acc. 2015/863/EU**. Our products with solder contact are suitable for lead-free soldering.

In general, Amphenol Tuchel Industrial is observing the availability of technical and ecological sensible replacement substances and is coordinating its activities with Amphenol's corporate **Product Stewardship Group**.
